Objectives of the National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) are:

- > to promote skill development and to bridge the gaps in providing the skill to the students who do not acquire during their study in colleges and thus to make them more employable; and
- to facilitate the employers to train disciplined and skilled manpower to meet the required human resources in the emerging areas.

Do you know more than 80% apprentices got employment after the apprenticeship training?

The post apprenticeship employment percentage under NATS is around 80% of total engagement. The employability percentage and details of students enrolled under NAT scheme is detailed below:
